
80 years of air and sea operations from Lann-Bihoué

1946

The Lann-Bihoué NAS was built on the ruins of the **German base of Kerlin-Bastard**, from which the *Luftwaffe** operated to protect U-boats** departing from Lorient. It quickly became home to **combat fleets, carrier-based fighter aircraft, and maritime patrol aircraft**.

Our strategic missions: from naval combat to protecting our coastlines

The Lann-Bihoué NAS has several crews on call 24 hours a day, 365 days a year:

- to support French submarines (ATL2)
- to lead operations, especially outside France (ATL2)
- to carry out search and rescue at sea (F50M)
- to cover occasionally permanent air security (Rafale or Mirage 2000)

The NAS prepares and supports all patrol, surveillance, and maritime intervention missions, departing from Lann-Bihoué and abroad, thanks to:

- Crew training and instruction
- Aircraft maintenance and repair

Lann-Bihoué's units



4F SQUADRON on E-2C Hawkeye

Operating from Lann-Bihoué and the Charles de Gaulle aircraft carrier, the squadron carries out advanced aerial detection, fighter control, command and control, air-sea and air-land space management missions.



21F and 23F SQUADRONS on Atlantique 2

They participate in anti-submarine warfare, anti-ship warfare, aeromaritime intelligence gathering, state action at sea, maritime counterterrorism, and air-land operations.

24F SQUADRON on Falcon 50M

Carrying out maritime defense missions of the territory, maritime surveillance, and search and rescue operations at sea.



28F SQUADRON on Xingu

Dedicated to pilot training and maturation, the squadron provides air liaison missions in support of the French Navy forces.



CEFAé Naval Aviation Training Center

Provides initial training for non-pilot flight personnel in the Naval Aviation Force, delivering basic training course (theory and practice).

It also provides training for maritime patrol, surveillance and intervention crews.



CENTEX PATSIMAR Center of expertise on maritime patrol, surveillance, and intervention

Ensures the operational qualification and advanced training of maritime patrol, surveillance, and intervention crews.

It also analyzes missions to advise crews and develop aircraft doctrine and equipment.
